

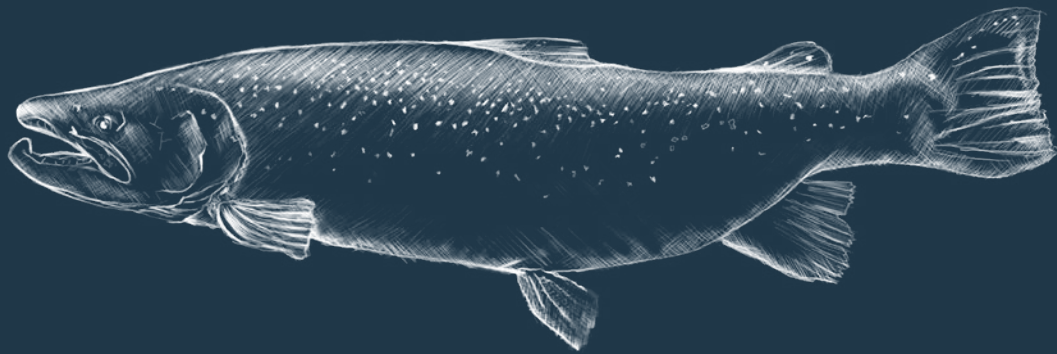

In 1984, the first fishing lodge ever was established on the Río Grande, it's name; Kau Tapen. Which, in the Ona Language, means "House of Fishing"; a fitting name as you won't find a better "home" from which to target the world's largest sea-run brown trout. Today, several decades later, its legendary waters continue to inspire and delight both newcomers and well-traveled anglers.

With the wind, most days at your back, Anglers will fish either single- or two-handed rods to pursue the prized sea-run trout. From skating bombers through broad tail-outs and swing streamers across the river's best beats to drifting nymphs against deep cut banks, anglers use an assortment of various methods to chase the fish that will haunt you for the rest of your days.

- Superb fishing gear and leading fishing equipment, available at no extra cost.





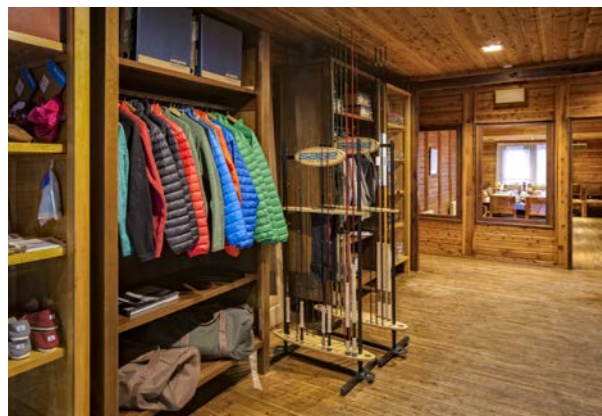
LOCATION

- Kau Tapen is located on the Rio Grande in the Province of Tierra del Fuego; Argentina.
- The lodge is located on the legendary “Estancia La Retranca”.
- 3-hour Nonstop flight from Buenos Aires to Rio Grande.
- Transportation from Rio Grande Airport to Lodge is 1 hour (4- wheel drive SUV).

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

- Capacity: 10 or 12 Anglers depending the week.
- Rooms: 10 en suite bedrooms (single and double occupancy).
- Main House: Dining room, sitting room, bar, wade gear room, and fully equipped fly-tying table.
- Spa: Dry sauna, steam room, massage room, relaxation hot tub and therapeutic shower.
- Telephone and Wi-Fi.
- Maid and Laundry Service.
- Unparalleled bird watching and rich wildlife (Condors, flamingos, goose, foxes, beavers and llama-like guanacos, among others).
- First class international and local guides. All of our guides are able to give casting instruction with single and two-handed rods (Spey casting).
- Comfortable 4-wheel drive trucks fitted with rod racks and VHF radios.
- Fly Shop: Fully equipped with flies, rods, reels, lines, fishing apparel, and Argentine crafts.



THE FISHING

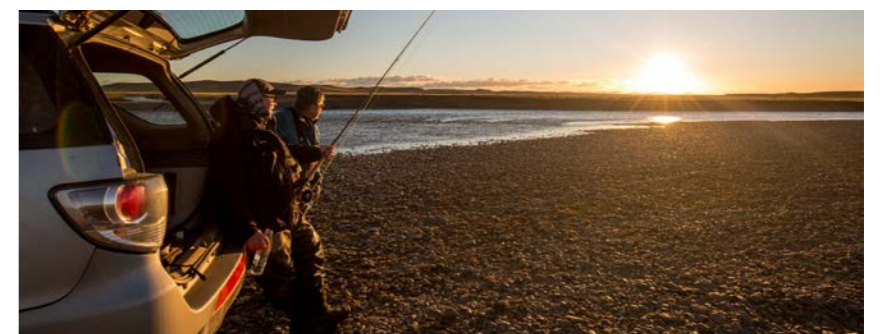
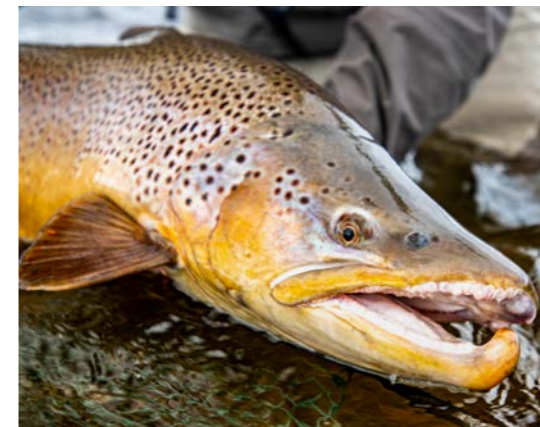
- At Kau Tapen we fish for Sea-Run Brown Trout weighing an average of 7 lbs and ascending to 30lbs and above.
- Our waters cover on 22km of the Rio Grande as well as 20km of the Rio Mendendez; both with private access.
- The river offers easy wading on fine gravel bottom.
- Tackle: Single-handed (7-9wt / 9-10 ft.) and Two-handed rods (7-8 wt / 12-15ft.).
- Flies: Small salmon dry flies, nymphs, traditional salmon and sea-run trout wet flies.
- Lines: Floating lines, Sink Tips and quick sink tips - depending on water conditions.

- **Fishing schedule:**

8:00 am Breakfast
 9:00 am Depart for fishing
 1:00 pm Lunch and Siesta
 4:00 pm Fish till dusk

The schedule will depend on the season and can be tailored to meet the preference of our guests.

- Guides are equipped with nets and will assist anglers in weighing and releasing fish quickly and without harm.

Non Angler Rate: \$650 per person per night

* Saturday to Saturday weeks (January 1 – March 12) includes: 1 night at Delta Eco Lodge (shared rooms), with one day of guided dorado fishing (subject to availability; first-come basis) with lunch, dinner and breakfast included – open bar.

Does not include transfer Ezeiza (EZE) Intl. Airport to Marina – Marina to Aeroparque (AEP) Domestic Airport (based on 2 pax min. at \$ 150 p/person)

- **Included:** Transfer from Rio Grande Airport to the Lodge, Accommodation, Meals, All wines, beer, local and international spirits, Professional guide services, loaner fishing equipment (Rods, reels & Lines).
- **Not included:** Gratuities for guides and house staff, international and domestic airfares, fishing license (\$495 approx. per person), laundry service and day-room (\$200 p/ person) based on single occupancy at Rio Grande Hotel on arrival date to Río Grande.
- **Payment terms:** Reservations are confirmed with a 50% deposit. All deposits are non-refundable, unless a client replacement is found. Final payment is due 60 days prior to departure. At this point, participants are responsible for total land costs and no refunds will be made for unused land transportation, accommodations or meals.
